Pickup Schedules

- Annual Spring Pickup: March 25 – May 3
- Annual Fall Pickup: October 1 – November 15

We will make one pass through the Village sometime during the last week of the month throughout the summer. Please put your yard waste out a couple days prior to the last week.

Allowable Materials for Annual Pickups: brush, yard and garden waste, concrete, cement blocks, stones and blacktop. NOTE: Please place brush in separate pile.

Not Allowed for Annual Pickups: stumps, branches over 8" in diameter, whole trees, and building materials (fencing, roofing, lumber, etc.)

Water Conservation

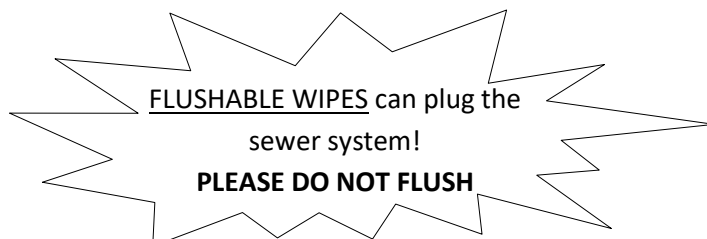
- Leaky toilets and faucets cause unnecessary waste of your water.

ANTICIPATED CAPITAL PROJECT

The Village anticipates doing two major capital improvement projects this year and into next year. One project will be to refurbish the elevated water storage tank, add carbon filtration to our process and replace sections of our water pipes some of which are 100 years old. The other will be to refurbish our sewer pump station, replace sewer pumps which are near the end of their useful life, video some sewer lines and repair, replace or line some of our sewer pipes.

These projects are expensive but necessary. The Village was successful in being awarded a \$1,620,000 grant toward the water project and a \$500,000 grant toward the sewer project. We are carefully analyzing the financial impact these projects will have to our current rates. The water fund is in better financial condition than the sewer fund and it is expected that the sewer rates will have to be adjusted upward.
