Mayor Harry G. Gutheil, Jr., Village of South Glens Falls, announces that the Village of South Glens Falls has declared a State of Emergency effective on March 15, 2020 which will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to the threat that COVID-19 poses to the health and welfare of the Village of South Glens Falls residents, visitors, and employees. No visitors or solicitors will be allowed entry. The Village is operating in accordance with its Village Emergency Preparedness Plan, as updated 5/2/2018 and voted upon by the Board of Trustees. **At this time, the Mayor and TJ Chagnon are the points of contact.**

This declaration means that Village Hall and all Village buildings will be closed to the general public until further notice.

The spring water and sewer bill payments should be left in the drop box in front of the Village Office from 9 am – 5pm. Residents are encouraged to pay by mail with a check or money order.
