1. Approve Bills

Mayor Gutheil stated that he went through them for the 1st time today. Most of them are part of a supplemental certificate which will be on the agenda for the next meeting.

He has heard that Delaware Engineering hired another engineering firm to assist them with no knowledge by the Board. Need to have a good session with Delaware because he is concerned how much money will be left for inspection work. The PFOA, PFOS project design is billed at 100% already.

Mayor Gutheil thinks they need to get this turned around or projects will not come in on budget.

The engineering report has been done for the new well and filed with DEC and Mayor Gutheil has read it.

Trustee Bodkin would like to see the Supplemental Certificate to review and approve. The Clerk Treasurer will send it out to the Board.

Trustee Bodkin stated that the reason why they can't get final drawings on the PFOA's is because they are still considering different options; even as of today. Mayor Gutheil agrees and said they should have reviewed all their options right up front.

Trustee Girard stated that he has asked Robert a number of times if they had enough staff to do the work.
