**VILLAGE OF SOUTH GLENS FALLS  
RESOLUTION  
AUGUST 6, 2025**

**WHEREAS** THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH GLENS FALLS has resolved and agreed to accept a grant from the Green Innovation Grant Program (GIGP) for its Water Meter Upgrade Program, Consolidated Funding Application (CFA) No. 105022, at a Board of Trustees' meeting held on August 6, 2025;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:**

**RESOLVED** that the Mayor is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation and any and all other contracts, documents, and instruments necessary to bring about the project and to fulfill the Village of South Glens Falls' obligations under the Grant Agreement.

**Authorization and Appropriation of Local Match**

GIGP: local match is a minimum of 25% of GIGP eligible project costs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:**

**RESOLVED** that the Village of South Glens Falls authorizes and appropriates a minimum (25%) local match as required by the Green Innovation Grant Program for the Water Meter Upgrade Program. Under the GIGP program, this local match must be at least 25% of the GIGP eligible project costs of approximately \$1,000,000.00. The source of the local match, and any amount in excess of the required match, shall be the Village's Water Fund. Please see the attached Funding Plan for alternative sources of financing. The maximum local match shall not exceed \$885,000.00 based upon a total estimated maximum project cost of approximately \$1,885,000.00. The Mayor, the designated representative for this project, may increase this local match through the use of in-kind services without further approval from the Village of South Glens Falls.

**SEQR Determination (Type II)**

**WHEREAS**, Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (6 NYCRR) Section 617.5 under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR) provides that certain actions identified in subdivision (c) of that section are not subject to environmental review under the Environmental Conservation Law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:**

**RESOLVED** that the Village of South Glens Falls hereby determines that the proposed Water Meter Upgrade Program is a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Section 617.5(c), pursuant to the following subsections, to wit:

- (1) maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility;
- (2) replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building, energy, or fire codes unless such action meets or exceeds any of the thresholds in section 617.4 of this Part; and
- (13) extension of utility distribution facilities, including gas, electric, telephone, cable, water and sewer connections to render service in approved subdivisions or in connection with any action on this list;

and is therefore not subject to further review under 6 NYCRR Part 617.

This is in regard to the late fee on our tax bill - \$35.90  
Our mortgage was paid in full in November 2024 - my husband, John Ball, went over to the village office sometime in November to let the clerk know that we needed to have the tax bill sent directly to us since we no longer have an escrow account. He doesn't remember who he spoke with but they took down the information, saying we were all set and would receive the bill in the mail.

I contacted the village office on July 11th letting them know we had not received the bill. I believe I spoke with "Laurie" she said she would mail it out immediately but did say we would have a late fee since the payment was due 7/1/25

(I was unaware of the due date since our payments always came from the escrow account - but I knew it was due in July which is why I called)

My husband dropped the check off on 7/15 - the woman he spoke with said they would present this to the board at the monthly meeting, she had him write the check for the amount of the tax bill (\$718.20) and told him if the board did not waive the late fee the \$35.90 would be added to our water bill.

Now, here it is July 29th and the check has not been deposited. I called the village office today, spoke with Laurie who explained this did not make the agenda for the July meeting and would be addressed at the meeting on August 6th.

We don't think it's fair we should have a late fee for July and hope there is not one for

August since you have not deposited the check.

This error is clearly on your end....we can't pay a bill if we never received one.

## **CURB AND/OR SIDEWALK AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 17 day of July, 2025 by and between THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH GLENS FALLS, a municipal corporation located in the County of Saratoga and State of New York, hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE", and David Centerbar located in the County of Saratoga and State of New York, hereinafter referred to as the "OWNER".

### **WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the parties hereto wish to have a sidewalk and/or curb constructed and installed adjacent to the real property located at 43 Second St, South Glens Falls, NY 12803; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village is willing to share the expenses of the construction and installation of sidewalk and/or curbing at the rate of fifty percent (50%);

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for the consideration hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

1. The Village shall construct and install plus or minus 240 square feet of sidewalk adjacent to the aforesaid real property at a total cost of \$1,680.00. Said cost to be shared as follows:


Village \$840.00/ Owner \$840.00.

**\*NOTE:** COST QUOTED IS AN ESTIMATE ONLY AND MAY BE HIGHER OR LOWER UPON COMPLETION

2. The Owner's contribution to the cost of construction and installation of curbing and/or sidewalk as aforesaid shall be due and payable within 30 days of completion of said curbing and/or sidewalk. Failure to receive payment within 30 days will result in a 10% penalty being assessed.
3. This agreement is executed on behalf of the Village by the Mayor of the Village of South Glens Falls, New York.
