SCHEDULING AND ASSIGNMENTS

The SGFPD has police officers assigned 24 hours per day, 365 days per year.

Assigned shifts are the overnight shift (12am-8am), day shift (8am-4pm), and evening shift (4pm-12am).

Officers are responsible to patrol the 1.5 square mile village, answering any police calls.

Calls For Service

 This department is an organization whose very existence is justified solely on the basis of community service. The greatest percentage of our calls for service are for non-criminal service functions and dealing with law abiding citizens of the village and those who are commuters. Most of our calls are from a citizen requesting assistance, and we fulfill these requests to the best of our abilities and limitations even if they are non-police related.

2019 SGFPD Statistics

- 3464 calls for service/average 9.49 calls per day
- 52 Penal Law arrests
- 13 DWI arrests
- 150 Motor Vehicle Crashes 15 were Personal Injury
- 433 Uniform Traffic Tickets issued
- 78 Parking Tickets issued
- Between 6 and 11 Sex Offenders monitored throughout the year.

- 1 Asian
- 3 Black
- 0 Indian

- 48 White
- 7.7% of arrests were people of color

2018-2020 Use Of Force

- No impact weapons used. No firearms discharged. 3 required the use of a Taser.
- All were Caucasian.
- Of the 5 uses of force, 2 were Mental Health violations and 3 were arrested for Penal Law offenses.

2018-2020 Additional SGFPD Miscellaneous Facts

- 0 Civilian Complaints against SGFPD.
- 3 responses to overdoses where Naloxone (Narcan) was administered by a responding officer resulting in no deaths.
- Numerous house and businesses checked by officers, usually during the night shifts.
- 76 vehicles unlocked by officers where the operator locked the key inside.
