

I have had a demo with the companies listed below for payroll software.

Below is a list of talking points on all software packages.

My personal recommendation is to go with Accu-Data. They are fully versed on what is now the hours required to submit retirement data to NYSLRS as well as a modern payroll system that can be tailored to our needs. This will allow for a timekeeping system to be implemented but still allow supervisors the flexibility they need to fit their individual department needs.
