- 1. Meeting is called to order at 7:00 PM. No one from the public wishes to speak at this time.
- 2. Motion to Approve the Bills as Audited: Motion #101922-2 to approve the bills as audited. Trustee Carota motions. Trustee Orlow seconds. Trustee Gutheil votes no. Motion passes.

Discussion: Trustee Gutheil asked who is controlling overtime for the Clerk's Office. Discussion: Trustee Gutheil asked why we were short of funds for the new furnace. Clerk Treasurer Berg stated there was an incorrect revenue posting that was not caught until afterwards.
